




# Hardin County Snapshot– 2011

## Commitments and Releases

<u>Commitments</u>	<u>Portion of County's Commitments</u>
Total –44 (.2% of total DRC commitments)	Truly Non-Violent Offenders – too small to be reliable
County's portion of state resident population – .28%	F4 and F5 –36.4 %
County's share of current DRC inmate population – .3%	Community Control Violators –11.4%


