

Risk Reduction Sentences

- Recommended by the court at the time of sentencing.
- Cannot be serving a sentence for aggravated murder, murder, complicity in committing aggravated murder or murder, an offense of violence that is a felony of the first or second degree, a sexually oriented offense, or an attempt or conspiracy to commit or complicity in committing any offense otherwise identified in this division if the attempt, conspiracy, or complicity is a felony of the first or second degree.
- Offender must agree to participate in a risks/needs assessment (ORAS) and complete all programming/treatment recommended by ODRC.
- If the offender completes all recommended programming, the offender may be released after serving all mandatory time, and at least 80% of their non-mandatory time. ODRC will notify the court 30 days prior to the offender's release.
- They are NOT eligible for earned credit.
- The offender will be supervised by the Adult Parole Authority for the remainder of his/her sentence on Monitored Time status if the offender was screened "NO" PRC in the institution. If the offender was screened "YES" for PRC; they will begin this period of active supervision upon release .
