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VICTIM NOTIFICATION

Victims of an offender in Ohio's prisons or under the supervision of the Adult Parole Authority are able to register with the Office of Victim Services to receive notification of the following:

- @ The offender's date to be released from prison;
- @ Upcoming hearings (including parole, transitional control, and clemency);
- @ Results of hearings;
- @ The offender's escape from custody;
- @ The offender's involvement in Intensive Program Prison (IPP);
- @ The offender's death;
- @ The offender's scheduled execution date, in death penalty cases;
- @ The offender's return to a county for a local hearing;
- @ The offender's status regarding transfer to another state for community supervision (Interstate Compact).
