

VICTIM NOTIFICATION

Victims of crime who register with the Office of Victim Services will receive notification of the following: (Notification is only provided regarding offenders who have been sentenced to prison or are under the supervision of the Adult Parole Authority.)

- @ The offender's date to be released from prison.
- @ Upcoming hearings (including parole, transitional control, and clemency)
- @ Results of hearings
- @ The offender's escape from custody
- @ The offender's involvement in Intensive Program Prison (IPP)
- @ The offender's death
- @ The offender's scheduled execution date, in death penalty cases
- @ The offender's return to a county for a local hearing
- @ The offender's status regarding transferring to another state for community supervision (Interstate Compact)

- To keep the Office of Victim Services informed as to your current address and telephone number.

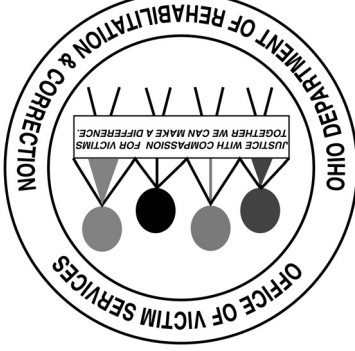
