RE: 2015 – Annual Jail Inspection

Dear Sheriff Risner:

In accordance with Section 5120.10 of the Ohio Revised Code and Executive Order 92-03 of the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Ashland County Jail, a Full Service Jail facility, was inspected on October 13th and 14th, 2015. The inspection was restricted to assessing compliance with a group of one hundred and seventeen (117) standards, selected from the Minimum Standards for Jails in Ohio promulgated by the Bureau of Adult Detention. The group of standards being inspected focused on reception and release, classification, security, housing, sanitation and environmental conditions, communication, visitation, medical/mental health, food service, recreation and programming, inmate discipline, administrative segregation, grievance, staffing, and staff training. Please note that this inspection does not reflect a comprehensive evaluation of the overall jail condition. The inspection consisted of this Inspector receiving and/or reviewing requested documentation and/or materials, touring selected areas of the jail, and having a brief interview with Sgt. Reed and Capt. Blake, Jail Administrator.


The total actual housing capacity for the Ashland County Jail (FSJ) is (127), consisting of (91) adult males and (15) adult females, (10) mixed (either adults or juveniles, and (11) special housing beds. On the date of the actual jail inspection, there were (101) inmates incarcerated in the Ashland County Jail (FSJ). The Bureau of Adult Detention's recommended housing capacity for the jail is (127), which is based upon total available living space and other requirements. Officials should maintain prisoner counts within the Bureau's recommended capacity figure. The Ashland County Jail (FSJ) is in compliance with the following standards:
