RE: 2015 Annual Jail Inspection

Dear Sheriff Minks:

This is a corrected copy of the inspection report previously completed on September 8, 2015. There was an error in the stating of the total actual housing capacity for the Washington County Jail.

In accordance with Section 5120.10 of the Ohio Revised Code and Executive Order 92-03 of the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Washington County Jail, was inspected on August 12th and 13th, 2015. The inspection was restricted to assessing compliance with a group of one hundred and seventeen (117) standards, selected from the Minimum Standards for Jails in Ohio promulgated by the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction. The group of standards being inspected focused on reception, classification, security, housing, sanitation and environmental conditions, medical, food service, recreation, administrative segregation, staffing, and staff training. Please note that this inspection does not reflect a comprehensive evaluation of the overall jail condition. The inspection consisted of this Inspector receiving and/or reviewing requested documentation and/or materials, touring selected areas of the jail, and having a brief interview with Lt. Rist, Lt. Martin, Lt. Smith, Chief Deputy Warden, and Jail Administrator – Lt. Thorpe.


The total actual housing capacity for the Washington County Jail is (136), consisting of (100) adult males, (24) adult females and (12) “as needed” beds. On the date of the actual jail inspection, there were (105) inmates incarcerated in the Washington County Jail. The Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction recommended housing capacity for the jail is (124), which is based upon total available living space and other requirements. Officials should maintain prisoner counts within the Department’s recommended capacity figure. The Washington County Jail is in compliance with the following standards:
