RE: 2015 Annual Jail Inspection


In accordance with Section 5120.10 of the Ohio Revised Code and Executive Order 92-03 of the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Columbian County Full Service Jail, was inspected on July 23rd and 24th, 2015. The inspection was restricted to assessing compliance with a group of one hundred and seventeen (117) standards, selected from the Standards for Jails in Ohio promulgated by the Bureau of Adult Detention. The group of standards being inspected focused on reception, classification, security, housing, sanitation and environmental conditions, medical, food service, recreation, administrative segregation, staffing, and staff training. Please note that this inspection does not reflect a comprehensive evaluation of the overall jail condition. The inspection consisted of this Inspector receiving and/or reviewing requested documentation and/or materials, touring selected areas of the jail, and having a brief interview with Warden Gary Grimm, Jail Administrator; and Assistant Warden Jay Nolte.

The total actual general housing capacity for the Columbian County Full Service Jail is (110); consisting of (80) adult males, (28) adult females, (2) Special Housing Capacity (medical area: adult males and females only). On the date of the jail inspection, there were (108) inmates incarcerated in the Columbian County Full Service Jail. The Bureau of Adult Detention's recommended housing capacity for the jail is (110) which is based upon total available living space and other requirements. Officials should maintain prisoner counts within the Bureau's recommended capacity figure. The Columbian County Full Service Jail (FS) is in compliance with the following standards below.
