- When making online reservations, all visitors being scheduled for the visit **MUST** be listed on the reservation and all visitors must be **APPROVED** visitors.

Visiting is limited to 2 visitors per Offender at one time. Each visiting session counts as a separate visit.

### **NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 YEARS WILL BE PERMITTED TO VISIT AT THIS TIME**

Reservations can be made up to 14 days in advance

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

Please plan to arrive up to a half hour before your session
All visitors will be required to take a rapid COVID test prior to being admitted for visiting. The rapid test takes approximately 15 minutes for results. A negative test screening is required in order to visit.

All Visitors will be issued a mask to wear throughout the course of visit and will be asked a series of COVID screening questions upon arrival
Inmates assigned to medical <b>for medical related reasons</b> are not eligible for visits
Inmates assigned to Quarantine areas are not eligible for visitation
TPU residents are permitted one visit per month (barring visitation restrictions-ex. RIB Rule 39 violations)
Please bring some form of Photo Identification
No Vending Machines will be available at this time
Lockers will be available for personal belongings (ex. Keys and wallets) in the Entry area
No Pictures will be taken with Residents at this time

<b>Please ensure clothing attire is appropriate for Visitation- See Details</b>
<b>** As a reminder, the dress code has not changed from your initial application process:</b>
<b>General Visiting Instructions</b>
<b>State of Ohio</b>
<b>Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction</b>
<b>1. All attire worn upon entry into the facility must be worn throughout the duration of the visit, with the</b>

exception of appropriate outerwear such as a coat and gloves.

2. Appropriate undergarments must be worn (i.e., bra, slip, and underwear).

3. No additional clothing is permitted to be carried into the facility.

4. Inappropriate attire includes, but is not limited to:

a. See-through clothing of any kind.

b. Tops or dresses that expose the midriff or have open backs or open sides (such as any sleeveless clothing such as halter tops, tube tops, cropped tops, tank tops, and muscle shirts).

c. Low-cut clothing cut in a manner that exposes the chest.

d. Any clothing that inappropriately exposes undergarments.

e. Skirts, dresses, shorts, skorts, or culottes with the hem or slit above the mid-knee.

f. Wrap-around skirts/dresses or break-away type pants.

g. Clothing with any gang related markings.

h. Clothing with obscene and/or offensive pictures, slogans, language and/or gestures.

i. Form-fitted clothing made from Spandex or Lycra or other similar knit material such as leotards, unitards, bicycle shorts, tight jeans, or tight pants.

j. Clothing with inappropriate holes/rips, including shoulder cut-outs.

5. No more than one wristwatch or pocket watch will be permitted.

6. Purses, handbags, backpacks, or similar items are not permitted.

7) All visitors are subject to clear the metal detector. The following items often prevent clearance of the metal detector:

a. Hairpins

b. Bras with metal underwires

c. Certain boots and shoes

d. Clothing with multiple zippers

e. Excessive jewelry
